



Advent Service of Light

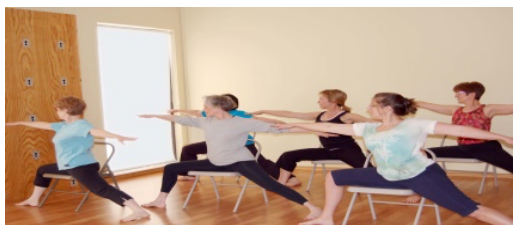

TUESDAY PROGRAMS



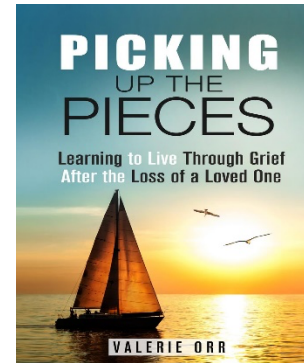

WEDNESDAY PROGRAM



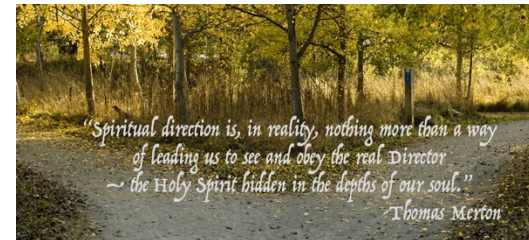
